And whereas it is necessary to declare the aims and objects of the public charitable trust, being constituted under these presents.

1. Now this Indenture witnesseth as follows:

That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the settler has set apart and handed over to the trustees, a sum of Rs. 51,000 Fifty one Thousand (hereinafter called the "Trust Fund" which expression shall include cash and any other property of investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof might be converted, invested or varied from time to time which may be acquired by the trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents), and the trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the trust subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

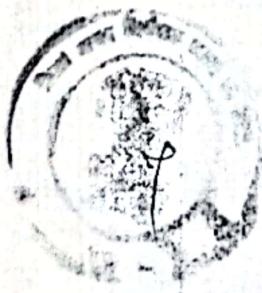
That the name of the trust shall be **INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS PROTECTION ASSOCIATION** and office will be situated at 104, Manorma Kunj, Nehru Nagar, Patna - 800001, Bihar [INDIA] and/or at such other place or places as the trustees may decide from time to time.

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a) To establish, develop, maintain technical and non technical institutions , schools, colleges, libraries, universities, laboratories, skill development centres, competition,

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preparation centres, yoga and spiritual centres, sports training centres, vocational training centres, research and other institutions for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge among the public in general.

- b) To establish, maintain and run studentship, scholarship and award programme and render other kind of aid to students including supply of study materials, books, stipend, medals and other incentives.
- c) To organise programme for the promotions of pre-primary education, non-formal education, computer & Information technologies, leadership development, techno-entrepreneurship development educational, Infrastructure research and development, socio-scientific research, management.
- d) Publish study-materials, magazine, books, information materials, journals, produce film, T.V. serials, documentaries, audio-video cassettes on burning social, educational and scientific issues.

II. In the field of Health & Family welfare: -

- a) To undertake, establish, assist, organise or conduct the programme of research, management and Infrastructure development in the field of health & family welfare.
- b) To establish, organise, run or maintain Hospital, Nursing Home, Care and Care Centres, Medical education and research centre in state-of-the-art.
- c) To undertake, organise, establish or run the medical education centre, college and research centre.
- d) To undertake awareness, prevention, surveillance, screening, management health

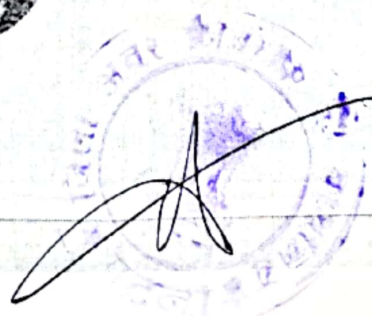
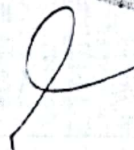

- f) To make the market-mechanism most favourable to the farmers. To develop the Infrastructure for the easy and safe delivery of agro-products. Also establish and run financial Institution for the benefit of agriculture and allied Industries-related people.
- g) To form and patronise self help group (S.H.G.) for the promotion of micro-credit and optimum financial benefit to the rural people.

IV. In the field of Environment & Forest: -

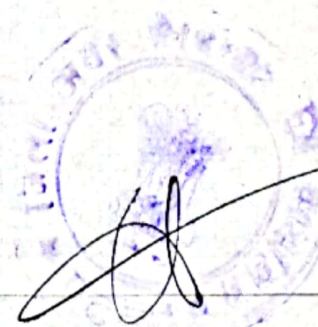
- a) To undertake all programmes for ensuring social accountability in conservation, preservation and control to the environment, forest, wild life.
- b) To undertake awakening and intervention programmes for enforcement of environmental law, Access to environmental Information, town and country planning, Integrated pollution control, atmospheric pollution, waste management, water pollution, sound pollution, exeretadisposal sedimentation and coagulation, treatment and disposal of sewage and sludge, bio-gas, water treatment methods and other nature conservation programmes.
- c) To organise and run special sanitation and environment protection programmes for Hospital, Fair, Melas, places of Pilgrimage, Railway stations, Bus stands, Canteens, Hotels, Industrial ergonomics.

V. In the field of Rural Development: -

- a) To promote education, training and research programmes in Rural Management and generate a Human Resource Force to settle the needs of people in rural as well as in urban areas.



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- b) To organise, conduct, sponsor, the intensive programme on Rural housing, Rural finance, Micro credit facility to the marginal farmer, Marketing mechanism Infrastructure development, Cottage & small scale industries development, co-operative and cooperation, wasteland Development Activity, Use of science & Bio-technology in rural areas to increase agro produce, Modern Technology Development Extension and training programme, Investment Promotion Schemes for the promotion of rural Infrastructure, watershed and water management (Water conservation and purification) Soil conservation and unutilized resource development programme, welfare and strengthening programme for marginal and underprivileged farmers, promotion of cost effective technologies, rural sanitation including low-cost drainage system.

VI. In the field of Social Justice & Empowerment: -

- a) To carryout all the programmes for the relief, rehabilitation, welfare and development of women in destitute, old-aged, handicapped, street children and child labour, widow, orphan, beggar, sex-worker, schedule caste, schedule tribes, backward and other under privileged people.
- b) To undertake and run the integrated programme on street children rehabilitation, juvenile justice, adoption resource, agency, social defence, civil defence, old age home/multi service centre, center of legal awareness, aids & rights, treatment and rehabilitation of addicts, persons with disabilities, coaching and allied assistance, construction of hostel building and other Infrastructure for complete rehabilitation



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centre, vocational training centres, women empowerment, animal welfare, stop prostitution, eradication of poverty.

VII. In the field of Urban Development: -




- a) To undertake, assist manage, organise the all programmes of urban development, social economical development particularly public health engineering, slum community rehabilitation and development, civic amenities and public services, town planning, master plan preparation and implementation, water and hydrometric studies, research and management, sewerage and drainage system and proper disposal of harmful waste, Solid waste management of house hold, Medico waste of hospitals and Nursing Homes and waste management. 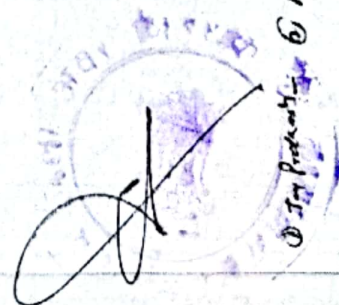
- a) To carryout all the programmes science & Technology and communication Information Technology for popularisation, use and inculcation of scientific temper among the people. Also ensure the use of technologies in the field of rural development, appropriate technology, rural technologies, environment and ecology, non-conventional energy, formal education, computer education etc.
- b) To organise the programme and set-up infrastructure, for the creation of techno-entrepreneurship through structured training programmes and other facilitating mechanisms.

(i) To accept any donation, contribution grant or subscription in cash or in kind,



- (viii) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity of charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
- (ix) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- (x) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.
- (xi) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise, to different charitable institutions, societies, organisations or trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereinafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, societies, organisation or trustees to start maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.
- (xii) To settle all accounts and to compromise, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (xiii) To borrow money either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the trustee to make such

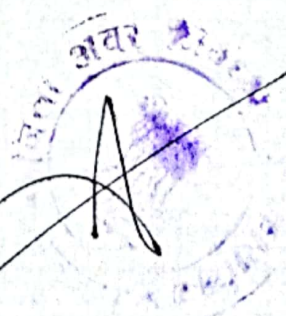


borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.

- (xiv) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, affiliation and other assistance with a view to promote the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to put to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
 - (xv) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, Trust, association, or Institution with similar objects.
 - (xvi) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing Institution or Institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
 - (xvii) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorised to amalgamate.
10. The Trustees shall be accountable only for such money, and funds which will actually come into their hands.

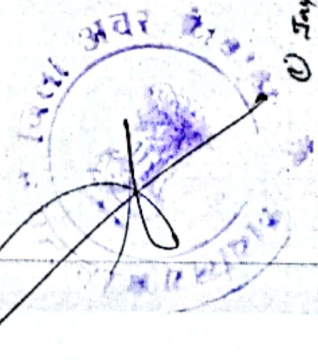
11. The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustee may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.
12. The Settler-cum-Managing Director for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to retirement and re-appointment as the trustees for the time being consider proper.
13. A person shall cease to be a Trustee either:
 - If he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meeting of the Trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer, or
 - If he is requested to resign by 3/4th or as near thereto as possible of the remaining trustees.
14. Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.

The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of trustees. In the absence of such regulations:

- (a) Five Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.
- (b) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustee.
- (c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two thirds of the trustees shall be as valid and

effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.

15. The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorise the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorised by these presents.
16. The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31ST March every year.
17. The Trust and the Trust funds shall be irrevocable for all the times.
18. It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provisions hereof shall be construed accordingly.
19. Two-thirds majority shall situate the office of the Trust at Patna unless changed by the Trustees.
20. POWER & FUNCTION OF THE OFFICE BEARER

SETTLER-CUM-MANAGING DIRECTOR:

The Settler-cum-Managing Director shall preside at all meetings of the trust, when he is present and shall exercise such other powers

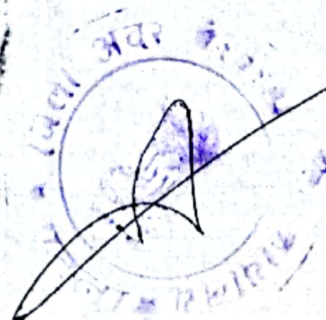
